



Miss M.A. Emerson – 1898 (Edition 1)

Miss M.A. Emerson who had been engaged in Christian work in Singapore for four years, came to New Zealand to visit her two brothers in 1898. While on that visit she was brought in touch with the assembly at Waverley where she was staying and as a result was convicted by the truth of the Scriptures and came into fellowship there. On returning to Singapore she met with the saints at Bethesda Hall and worked amongst the Malay-speaking Chinese women by whom she was very well received. Her work though not spectacular, was very effective, and she was a blessing to very many because she had learned the Malay language.

After a short illness she was admitted to hospital for an operation, but a month later passed away on June 15th 1918, aged 59 years.
